Our 256-bit encrypted portal (same as internet banking) manages the end-toend parent ordering process including direct debit, pupil premium, free school meal and multi academy trust management without the need to have different portals for different student groups or multiple schools within a large trust.

Importantly all our systems are owned and operated by Edutech Zone Ltd in the UK, we do not outsource any of our systems or processes.

Real-time management reporting

Our comprehensive real-time management reporting provides IT, finance, and business managers with up-todate scheme information at the touch of a button.

Our reporting includes scheme set up, parent orders and approvals, a detailed financial breakdown of each element of the scheme as well as monthly direct debit management reports.

For IT we also capture device serial numbers, insurance, and warranty claims data.





We make no charge for our services - all costs are included in the parent contribution model.

There is no admin or set up fees for our education operating lease services and if a device is damaged or suffers a mechanical failure it is repaired or replaced under the comprehensive support package.

Integrated direct debit management

Our parent direct debit collection services are administered by us so parents do not have to contact a third party when they need to change the date of their direct debit or have financial questions.
